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As a theatre company, we strongly believe in our responsibility towards the reality that surrounds us. We believe that theatre should be a critical reflection of society, a space from which to question established norms, and a pretext to contribute to the construction of a more just and empathic world.

To do so, we try to listen, stay open and live our day-to-day issues in a conscious way. For this new spectacle, we have directed our attention to the stories and emotions that touches and challenges us the most. Those that come from La Mariola, the neighbourhood where we have our headquarter. It's a historically stigmatized district, marked by deep social inequalities but at the same time, one that has - on many occasions – proved it's resilience and strength. Over the years, we have been able to get to know its stories, realities, and enormous potential. This relationship with the community that surrounds us is what has inspired us to tell the story of Amal, who, like many inhabitants of this neighbourhood, has had to leave her land in search of a better life.

Amal's story is universal. One that all of us can relate to, regardless of our origins, background, or life experience. At a time when the performing arts face significant challenges in attracting new audiences, choosing different narratives that give voice to new protagonists allows diverse audiences to attend theatres and identify with the stories being told.

All of this presented in a completely innovative format for us! We've merged top-level circus, led by Laia Gómez and Ona Vives, with the characteristic style and unique universe of La Baldufa, which has been our distinctive hallmark for more than twenty-seven years.

<u>SYNOPSIS</u>

September 6th. I start my journey to Europe. September 8th. The night is dark. The sea is angry. September 10th. I made it. I've crossed the Mediterranean.

On the outskirts of a city, in an old courtyard, Amal hides as she escapes. She is a young woman who, after experiencing the horrors of war, has had to leave her country in search of refuge in Europe. She cannot imagine that in the very same place, another girl has also sought refuge to escape her own anxieties and concerns. Perhaps they will discover that they share more than they could have imagined...

"Amal" means hope in Arabic. And that is what we want this story to be: a tale about people, life, and the hope of creating a better world. In a complex and challenging time we believe that artists must take part, get involved, and engage with the society we live in. This also means telling stories that are thought-provoking, proposing ideas that challenges the audience and stir things up. That reinforces the role of culture as a bastion of freedom from which we forge a necessary critical spirit to reinvent the world we inhabit. In short, to contribute to creating a more just society.









THE PROJECT

A theater and circus show, with the Baldufa signature.

Our intention has been to create a **show that merges theater with circus**, a discipline we hadn't explored previously as creators, while **maintaining the characteristic style and visual universe** of the company.

The Circus World has always inspired and intrigued us. It's a discipline that has been very present in our professional history: we have shared stages with high-level circus projects and artists, observed how these have increasingly gained prominence in theater and festival programs, and witnessed the emergence of increasingly diverse and eclectic circus proposals.

Now, at this moment of our journey, we believed that we have reached the creative and professional maturity necessary to undertake this new adventure and make our own contribution to this discipline.

To do so, we sought out the collaboration of two high-level circus artists, **Ona Vives and Laia Gómez (Laiaiona**), a duo specializing in Icarian Games and Hand to Hand. They are the ones who, for the first time in a Baldufa show, take to the stage and carry out the interpretative part.





BRIEF BIOGRAPHY LA BALDUFA

Premio Nacional de Artes Escénicas para la Infancia y la Juventud 2020 (National Prize for Performing Arts for Children and Youth)

Companyia de Comediants La Baldufa was founded in Lleida in 1996. Over the past 25 years, we have been committed to creating **high-quality and innovative performing arts shows**, aimed at all audiences, but primarily focusing on families. One defining aspect of La Baldufa's identity is that our entire creation, even the company's day-to-day activities, has a background of **commitment to social causes**, which has accompanied us throughout our existence.

When creating, we mix this social commitment with our distinctive visual world: "the Baldufa aesthetic", which we put at the service of dramaturgy. Clown and gestural theater are the styles in which we feel most comfortable, but we also enjoy artistic crossbreeding and mixing different disciplines. Our creative process is extensive and global. We slow-cook our performances, and during the production process, we try to engage in residencies and stays in theaters to fully immerse ourselves in creation and build connections with the welcoming territory. All this, always surrounded by a first-class team, both in management and artistic roles, which allows us to grow day by day as a company.

Undoubtedly, **we advocate for theater for all audiences** and strongly believe in the value that children hold in society. It is during childhood that individuals form their artistic and cultural concepts; thus, creation for children and families should be of high quality, rigorous, and contemporary, at the same level as those aimed at adults. For these reasons and because we also believe in defending cultural rights, we are members of the associations **CIATRE**, **TTP** and **ASSITEJ**.

In 2020, we had the immense honor of receiving the **Premio Nacional de Artes Escénicas para la Infancia y la Juventud 2020** (National Prize for Performing Arts for Children and Youth) granted by the Ministry of Culture and Sport of the Government of Spain. This award recognizes the company's trajectory, highlighting the "conception of the viewer as a capable, critical, and reflective being regardless of age" and the ability to create visually rich poetic universes. Furthermore the company has received several awards with its shows, including the **RECOMMENDED** Seal assigned by Red Española de Teatros, Auditorios y Festivales de Titularidad Pública through its artistic commissions, for most of the company's shows.

Throughout these years, we have been able to perform in many national stages and festivals, such as the **Teatre Nacional de Catalunya**, the **Teatro Español**, the **Gran Teatre del Liceu**, La **Fira del Teatre al Carrer de Tàrrega**, the **Festival Grec de Barcelona** or la **Fira de Titelles de Lleida**, as well as in many **European and international festivals**. We have also carried out several international creative residencies and have been present in most of the Catalan and Spanish theatrical circuits and networks.

As a result of the social concern that drives us, for several years now, we have been carrying out small social and cultural actions in our neighborhood, an area characterized by a high level of segregation, migration, poverty, and social exclusion. Since the year 2022, we have also been organizing in this area the <u>Enre9 Live Arts Festival</u>, with the aim of empowering and revitalizing the area and its inhabitants. Since 2008 and until 2023, we have also organized the **Festival** Esbaiola't in Esterri d'Àneu with the aim of offering quality culture for children and families in the Valls d'Àneu, in the Catalan Pyrenees.



BRIEF BIOGRAPHY: DUO LAIAIONA

Laia Gómez and Ona Vives

Ona and Laia are both born in Catalonia. They met at Roglio Rivel circus school in 2016 where they started '**Laiaiona project**'. Since then they have been developing as performers within the disciplines of **Icarian Games and Hand to Hand.**

They graduated from Codarts Circus Arts in 2021 and since then they have been working in diferent companies. At the moment they are performing "NUYE" with Circo Eia, "AMAL" with La Baldufa and "AMBDUES", their own short piece.

One of the characteristics of their work has been the mix of these two disciplines, always from a playful and humoristic aproach; one of the inspirations they have is the relationship with others and with the enviorment.











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
