STANDARD TECHNICAL DOSSIER

PERFORMING SPACE

This show takes place within a circular space, surrounded by grandstands, where the audience sit, which form part of the scenery.

The capacity is of 135 people.


It's an autonomous show. It can be performed either on the stage of a theatre, or in any indoor space (such as a sports centre, a multi-purpose room, a warehouse...). It can be performed outdoors, as well. No matter whether it is daytime or night-time. The structure of the grandstands contains the lighting and the sound for the show. The stage includes its own floor provided by the theatre company.

With this staging structure, the show intends to embrace the audience as one more actor of the whole story throughout the performance, so that not only collapses the fourth wall, but also the aim of making every performance unique becomes real.



SHOW REQUIREMENTS

- The company needs 5h to set up the stage and 2h to take it down, approximately.
- The minimum stage measurements are 12m x 12m x 4.5m.
- The ground for the performing space must be firm.
- For outdoor or open-air performances, the organization must clearly mark the zone, with a minimum size of 14m x 14m.
- 2 power outlets of at least 4 amps each are needed.
- If there is none available, the organisation must prepare a place as a dressing room, large enough for three people.
- The 15m long vehicle [van + trailer] must be able to access the performing space to set up the stage. If this is impossible, 4 people will be needed to load and unload.
- The organisation should provide a parking place for the 15m long vehicle [van + trailer].
- The organisation should be there to meet the company when they arrive.
- The organisation should regulate the audience access to the performance area, with an adequate amount of staff.
